





Background

- In 2015, the Mayor and City Council tasked the Economic Development Commission with developing recommendations for a citywide Blueprint for Economic Development
- The Commission consists of 11 members that represent various different sectors



Blueprint Planning Process

- Policy document that outlines goals, objectives, and recommendations to provide a catalyst for economic activity across the city
- Deliverables:
 - High-level policy document (Blueprint)
 - Work plan for further assessment and strategy development
 - Online dashboard to track key performance indicators
