SUBJECT: Agreement Between the Long Beach Unified School District and the City of Long Beach for Use of the Long Beach Police Department Pistol Range

(District 5)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) would like to enter into an agreement with the City of Long Beach for use of the Police Department Pistol Range for the school safety officers in its School of Safety and Emergency Preparedness Division. The Range will be used for qualification and training purposes as necessary to perfect their firearm skills and in compliance with pistol range policies as determined by the Long Beach Police Department.

The LBUSD currently has 21 school safety personnel whose primary function is to provide campus security and safety. The Long Beach Police Department and LBUSD have had a long-standing positive working relationship. Both organizations cooperate to provide education and training of benefit to both; approval of their use of the Range will enhance our efforts to provide for the safety of the community. The use of the range by LBUSD will not require additional Police Department staff commitment.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Charles Parkin and Budget Management Officer David Wodynski on July 14, 2004.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on August 3, 2004, to allow LBUSD officers access to the Range at the earliest opportunity.

FISCAL IMPACT

LBUSD will be charged \$150 per officer per year or a total of approximately \$3,150. These funds will be deposited into the General Fund (GP) of the Police Department (PD).

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL:

Authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement and any subsequent amendments with the Long Beach Unified School District for use of the Long Beach Police Department Pistol Range, on an as-needed basis, for the school safety officers of the School of Safety and Emergency Preparedness Division to qualify and train. The agreement may be terminated with thirty (30) days' written notice by either party.
