3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT
5 CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
7 EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR
8 MISCELLANEOUS MANAGERS REPRESENTED BY THE
9 LONG BEACH MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION AND FOR
10 UNREPRESENTED MANAGEMENT MISCELLANEOUS
11 EMPLOYEES TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
12 RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)

14 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
15 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement
17 which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the
18 employer, and reported as special compensation; and

19 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section is
20 the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving notice
21 of its intention to commence paying and reporting the value of employer paid member
22 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as identified
23 herein.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
25 follows:

26 Section 1. Effective as of February 26, 2011, the governing body of the City
27 of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to
28 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member Contributions

1 (EPMC) for miscellaneous managers represented by the Long Beach Management
2 Association and for unrepresented management miscellaneous employees. This benefit
3 shall consist of the City paying 6% of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting
4 the same percent value of compensation earnable, excluding special compensation
5 pursuant to Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The
6 employee shall pay 2% of the normal contribution.

7 Section 2. New City employees hired on or after February 26, 2011, who
8 are unrepresented management miscellaneous employees or miscellaneous employees
9 represented by the Long Beach Management Association shall pay 100% of the normal
10 contributions and the City shall pay 0% of the normal contributions.


11 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
12 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
