Don Knabe Basketball Courts

**Background**: The basketball courts park on 14<sup>th</sup> Street at Locust are being rebuilt with brand new poles, baskets, surfacing, seating, fencing, and paint. Together they will create a basketball park of multiple courts and amenities. The completely new courts are part of the revitalization of the entire 14<sup>th</sup> street greenbelt and the surrounding community, which has included a new skate park, the new Seaside Park, and other improvements.

Los Angeles County Supervisor Don Knabe has given indispensable support to these projects, and in particular secured funding from the County to get to build the new basketball courts. Supervisor Knabe is a consistent and enthusiastic partner to the City of Long Beach, supporting our efforts to improve our City at every turn.

To honor his contributions to this project and to Long Beach, it is appropriate to name the new basketball courts at 14<sup>th</sup> Street the "Don Knabe Basketball Courts." The naming has the support of the Washington Neighborhood Association, and numerous local community leaders.
