RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the permit with conditions on the application of Ashley's Bar & Grill LLC, DBA Ashley's Bar & Grill, 1731 E. 4th Street, for Entertainment Without Dancing by Patrons at an existing Restaurant. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, an entertainment permit with conditions shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

Attached for your review is the application from Ashley's Bar & Grill LLC, DBA Ashley's Bar & Grill. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions.

- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Restaurant with Alcohol since November 1974.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Kendra Carney on November 22, 2010.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of December 14, 2010, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT



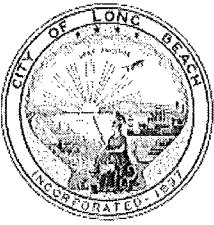

Application for Entertainment without Dancing

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment without Dancing, the Department of Financial Management recommends **approval subject to the following conditions:**

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #1}*
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #2}*
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 10 PM Sunday through Thursday nights, and 12:30 AM on Friday and Saturday nights. *{New}*
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible fifty (50) feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment, or offering non-amplified entertainment. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #4}*
- 5) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed, or **10 p.m., whichever comes first**. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #5}*
- 6) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over fifty (50) people the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Ashley's employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #6}*

- 7) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #7}*
- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors." *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #8}*
- 9) The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit or loiter near the side door leading to the alley or the rear kitchen door at anytime during business hours. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #9}*
- 10) The permittee and/or security shall also ensure that no employee, patron, or entertainer loiters in the parking lot at anytime during the operation of the business. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #10}*
- 11) The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #11}*
- 12) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #12}*
- 13) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #13}*
- 14) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #14}*
- 15) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to the use remaining as a restaurant, meaning a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals.

"Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deemed compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on

the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available.

The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals.

In the event the primary business ceases operations, fails to operate as a bona fide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #15}*

- 16) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise, promote, or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #16}*
- 17) Ashley's Bar & Grill, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #17}*
- 18) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras. *{New}*
- 19) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply. *{Issued per One-Year Short-Term permit dated 5/5/09; see condition #18}*

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment without Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following eighteen (18) conditions of operation:

Ashley's Bar & Grill is located on the north side of 4th Street between Walnut and Hermosa Avenues and has been in business since 1938. The establishment serves a domestic food menu for lunch and dinner. Ashley's parking lot is located directly across the street from the business, on the south side of 4th Street, and has approximately 20 parking spaces. Mark Kaake and Mary Goodwin have owned the business for approximately two years, and have been operating on a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit. Based upon the Long Beach Police Department's investigation, the South Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and input from neighborhood residents, the Long Beach Police Department does not believe the issuance of an Entertainment Permit without Dancing will have an adverse impact on Patrol Division resources.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 10 PM Sunday through Thursday nights, and 12:30 AM on Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment, or offering non-amplified entertainment.

- 5) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed, or **10 p.m., whichever comes first.** Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition.
- 6) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Ashley's employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 7) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 9) The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit or loiter near the side door leading to the alley or the rear kitchen door at anytime during business hours.
- 10) The permittee and/or security shall also ensure that no employee, patron, or entertainer loiters in the parking lot at anytime during the operation of the business.
- 11) The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
- 12) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 13) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.

- 14) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 15) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. In the event the primary business ceases operation on a permanent basis, meaning meals are no longer offered at the location, then the entertainment permit becomes null and void.
- 16) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise, promote, or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 17) Ashley's Bar & Grill, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 18) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

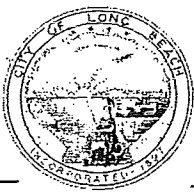

The Current Planning Division of the Department of Development Services has the following comments:

A review of the permit history for 1731 E. 4th Street, indicates there have been no CUPs or AUPs approved for the subject property.

The applicant is seeking to obtain a permit for entertainment without dancing. An entertainment permit without dancing is allowed as an accessory use at a restaurant in the CNR zone. No extra parking is required.
