FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 32733

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 32733 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 11, 2012 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on April 19, 2005, by and between BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES, INC. DBA JOINT EFFORTS, INC., a California nonprofit corporation, with offices located at 505 S. Pacific Avenue, Suite 201, San Pedro, California 9073 (hereafter "Subcontractor"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation (hereafter "Contractor" or "City").

WHEREAS, Contractor has entered into a Contract for City's Family Preservation Program (hereafter "Prime Contract") with the County of Los Angeles (hereafter "County"); and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its obligations to County under the Prime Contract, Contractor desires to engage Subcontractor to provide community preservation network services; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Subcontract No. 32733 whereby Subcontractor agreed to perform such work; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend certain terms of the Subcontract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions contained in the Subcontract and this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of Subcontract No. 32733 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "3. <u>TERM OF SUBCONTRACT</u>. The term of this Subcontract shall commence on July 1, 2012 and shall expire on June 30, 2013, unless terminated earlier pursuant to any of the conditions for termination in the Prime Contract."
- 2. The Rates and Services in Exhibit "B-1", attached to this First Amendment and incorporated by this reference, are effective as of January 1, 2013.
 - 3. Except as expressly amended in this First Amendment, all terms and

Subcontractor will provide all services and documentation in compliance with requirements in the Prime Contract and the Family Preservation Program Statement of Work (Exhibit A-2 of the Prime Contract). Subcontractor will be responsible for all related administrative functions, including but not limited to: all required case documentation and reporting, Family Preservation Archive data collection and data entry, staff training and supervision, Auxiliary Fund requests, and quality assurance activities.
