I also anticipate 4 bike-related projects going out to bid in 2015 (including 3 bike boulevards) from our Traffic Division, but do not yet have schedules for those. Please be aware that the construction estimates are very rough, and not based on our final engineers estimates.

Based on this, you should note that our average from Public Works over the next year should be over 2 projects per month, which is a bit more than last year, as several of our project designs are now coming to fruition. It should also be noted that this does not include the upcoming projects from either the Airport Department or the Tidelands Division in the City Manager's Office. Finally, it should also be noted that this list does not include any RFPs for professional services, of which we also anticipate a few in 2015.
