RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0090

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF
MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS FOR THE
PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE ACQUISITION AND
CONSTRUCTION OF THE LONG BEACH SENIOR ARTIST
COLONY

WHEREAS, the California Statewide Communities Development Authority (the "Authority") is authorized by the laws of the State of California (the "Law") to execute and deliver multifamily housing revenue obligations for the purpose of financing the acquisition, construction/rehabilitation and development of multifamily residential rental facilities located within the area of operation of the Authority which are to be occupied, in part, by very low and low income tenants; and

WHEREAS, Long Beach Senior Artist Colony, LP, a California limited partnership, or such other limited liability company or limited partnership related thereto or formed by META Housing Corporation (the "Borrower"), has requested the Authority to issue and deliver multifamily housing revenue obligations in the anticipated principal amount of \$30,000,000 (the "Obligations"), the proceeds of which may only be used for the purpose of financing the acquisition and construction of a 147-unit multifamily residential rental facility to be commonly known as the Long Beach Senior Artist Colony to be located at 1235 Long Beach Boulevard in the City of Long Beach, California (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Obligations which are expected to be issued and delivered to finance the acquisition and construction of the Project would be considered "qualified exempt facility bonds" under Section 142 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and Section 147(f) of the Code requires that the "applicable

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elected representatives" with respect to the jurisdiction in which the Project is located hold, or cause to be held, a public hearing with respect to the issuance and delivery of the Obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer's Office of the City of Long Beach, on behalf of the "applicable elected representatives" of the City of Long Beach, has held said public hearing at which all those interested in speaking with respect to the proposed financing of the Project were heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. For purposes of the requirements of the Code only, the City Council hereby approves the proposed financing of the Project by the Authority with the proceeds of the Obligations.

Section 3. The issuance and delivery of the Obligations shall be subject to the approval of and execution by the Authority of all financing documents relating thereto to which the Authority is a party and subject to the sale of the Obligations by the Authority.

Section 4. The adoption of this Resolution is solely for the purpose of meeting the requirements of the Code and shall not be construed in any other manner. the City nor its staff having fully reviewed or considered the financial feasibility of the Project or the expected financing or operation of the Project with regards to any State of California statutory requirements, and such adoption shall not obligate (i) the City to provide financing to the Borrower for the acquisition, construction and development of the Project or to issue the Obligations for purposes of such financing; or (ii) the City, of or any department of the City, to approve any application or request for, or take any other action in connection with, any environmental, General Plan, zoning or any other permit or other action necessary for the acquisition, construction, development or operation of the
