**SUBJECT:** Agreement With the California Department of Health Services for the Provision of a Chlamydia Awareness and Prevention Program (Citywide)

---

## DISCUSSION

Since January 1, 2000, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has provided a Chlamydia Awareness and Prevention Project under a grant from the State of California, Department of Health Services (State). Under this agreement, DHHS staff provides outreach and prevention education to those at high-risk for Chlamydia infection. The proposed agreement with the State extends the program for an additional five years, from July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2009, and provides annual funding in the amount of \$23,388, for a total contract amount of \$116,940.

This matter was reviewed by Senior Deputy City Attorney Donna Gwin on August 5, 2004 and Budget Management Officer David Wodynski on August 10, 2004

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The DHHS has been providing services under this agreement since July 1, 2004 but cannot recover costs from the State until the amendment is approved. Therefore, City Council approval is requested on August 17, 2004.

## FISCAL IMPACT

The total amount of the agreement is \$116,940 for five years. An appropriation increase of this amount is included in the recommendations below.

Authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents with the State of California Department of Health Services to provide Chlamydia Awareness and Prevention Program services in an amount not to exceed \$116,940 for a five-year period, and increase appropriations in the Health Fund (SR 130) and the Department of Health and Human Services (HE) by \$116,940.
