3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO PURCHASE OFFICE FURNITURE FROM
6 ALLSTEEL, INC. THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN
7 STATE OF CALIFORNIA MULTIPLE AWARD SCHEDULE
8 (CMAS) FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING
9

10 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the
11 City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government
12 agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when
13 authorized by resolution; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase office furniture from
15 AllSteel Inc.; and

16 WHEREAS, the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) has a
17 contract for the purchase of office furniture under Contract No. 4-01-01-0060A ("State
18 Contract"); and

19 WHEREAS, City's participation in the State Contract will facilitate acquisition
20 of office furniture as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

21 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
22 State Contract, considerably more funds would be required;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
24 follows:

25 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
26 hereby by this reference.

27 Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to
28 enter an agreement with AllSteel Inc. to purchase office furniture of the same type and kind

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1 purchased by the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) pursuant to the
2 State Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and
3 AllSteel Inc. and the purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and
4 conditions afforded to the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) in an
5 amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 (which includes tax) plus an additional 2% of that
6 base amount if needed for unforeseen expenses, for a period extending until the warranty
7 on these items expires.


8 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the
9 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
