Launched in May, 2010, the "Food for Thought" Campaign focuses on three fundamental health-related issues in Long Beach public schools in order to ensure that all students can thrive, attend school healthy and ready-to-learn, and graduate prepared for college, careers, and community participation:

- 1. Healthy Bodies: including access to healthy and nutritious foods in Long Beach schools and low-income neighborhoods.
- 2. Healthy, Green Environments: including access to good air quality and clean and safe places for learning and recreation in Long Beach schools and low-income neighborhoods.
- 3. Healthy Minds: including positive race relations, self-identity, diversity awareness, and emotional and social supports in Long Beach schools and communities.

Recommendation: Request City Attorney prepare "Food for Thought" resolution in support "Healthy School Zones" in the City of Long Beach.
