A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH REGARDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY PURCHASING AGENT WITH RESPECT TO THE PURCHASE OF LIVESCAN FINGERPRINT SERVICES AND SUMMARY CRIMINAL HISTORIES AND COUNTY PRISONER BOOKING SERVICES

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 11105(e) authorizes the California Department of Justice (the "DOJ") to charge the City of Long Beach (the "City") certain fees for providing the City with LiveScan fingerprinting services and summary criminal histories of applicants for employment by the City; and

WHEREAS, the amount of such fees are determined by the DOJ pursuant to California Penal Code Section 11105(e); and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 29550(a) authorizes the County of Los Angeles (the "County") to charge the City for providing the City with booking and processing services at County jails; and

WHEREAS, the amount of such fees are determined by the County pursuant to California Government Code Section 29550(a); and

WHEREAS, it is not possible to contract for the services described above with any entities other than the DOJ and the County, respectively, and the fees imposed therewith are required by statute and are non-negotiable; and

WHEREAS, increases in fees and increases in usage of the services described above will result in annual blanket purchase orders for each service in excess of

1 \$100,000.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
3 follows:

4 Section 1. The City Purchasing Agent is authorized to issue blanket  
5 purchase orders for amounts not exceeding Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000)  
6 annually with the DOJ for summary criminal histories and fingerprinting services.

7 Sec. 2. The City Purchasing Agent is authorized to issue blanket purchase  
8 orders for amounts not exceeding Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) annually  
9 with the County for providing the City with booking and processing services at County jails.

10 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the  
11 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
