RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term permit with conditions for an entertainment permit without dancing by patrons at LBC Beverages, Inc., DBA Clancy's, 803 E. Broadway. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved; if not, it shall be denied.

Attached for your review is the application from LBC Beverages, Inc., DBA Clancy's. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term permit with conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Long Beach Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be approved.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a bar/tavern/lounge since October 2005.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of July 1, 2008, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on June 3, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Inspection \$300 and Zoning Review \$14 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,000 (Police Department), Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$299.88 and Regulatory \$250 (Financial Management Department).

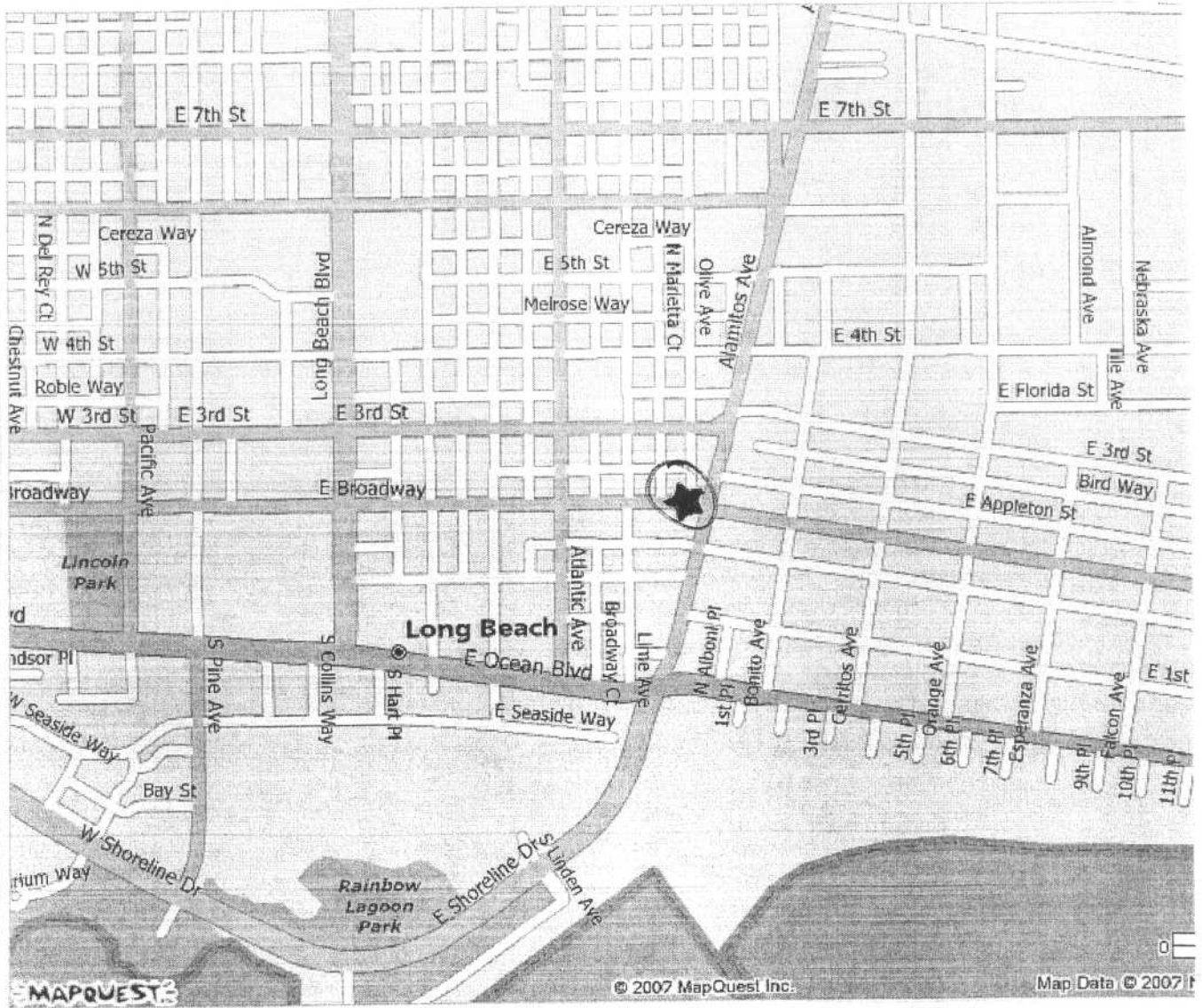

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment without Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of a **One-Year Short-Term** permit, subject to the following eighteen (18) conditions of operation:

On February 20, 2007, the City Council approved a one-year short-term Entertainment without Dancing permit. During this period, there were only a few incidents related to the operation of the business. However, the owner has also been in violation of his current entertainment conditions by allowing karaoke past midnight during the week.

Due to non-compliance related to conditions of operation, the Police Department believes that another one-year short-term permit would be in the best interest of the City of Long Beach. This would allow the owner an opportunity to come into compliance with his conditions of operation.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) The permittee shall be required to meet with the Health Department to discuss the best solutions to mitigate any noise issues arising from the operation of his business. The permittee shall also develop a plan to address neighborhood concerns, related to the operation of Clancy's. (i.e. newsletter, meetings, etc.)
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12 midnight Sunday through Thursday nights, and 2:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.

- 5) Clancy's shall not advertise, procure, nor allow any person, performance, show, promotion, or any other event or entertainment that exposes or promotes, encourages, or allows the exposure of the male or female genitals, cleft of the buttocks, the areola or any portion of the female breast below the areola, while at or inside the business.
- 6) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor to remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed, or **10 p.m.**, whichever comes first. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition.
- 7) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 8) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Clancy's employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 9) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 10) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 11) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 12) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.

- 13) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- 14) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. In the event the primary business ceases operations on a permanent basis, meaning meals are no longer offered at the location period, the entertainment permit becomes null and void.
- 15) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 16) Clancy's, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 17) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 18) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
