Adopt Specifications WD-41-22 for the Alamitos Tank Nos. 19 & 20 Conversion Project (REO-0208) and authorize the General Manager to sign a construction contract with Paso Robles Tank, Inc., in the amount of \$5,615,199.

Executive Summary

On March 11, 2022 and March 18, 2022, staff published the Notice Inviting Bids for the Alamitos Tank Nos. 19 & 20 Conversion Project (REO-0208) as required by Public Contract Code Section 22037. The Project involves furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to convert the existing Alamitos Tanks 19 and 20 from potable to recycled water tanks, including but not limited to: replacement of internal coating, external paint, cathodic protection systems, pipes, valves, and roof supports; and installation of a new recycled water mainline, electrical panels, conduits, pumps, and pressure transmitters.

On March 28, 2022, five (5) bids were received and opened. The bid tabulation is attached. The lowest responsive bid submitted by Paso Robles Tank, Inc., in the amount of \$5,615,199, was found to be in conformance with the bid documents.

The Engineer's estimate is \$6,780,000.

Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-41-22 for the Alamitos Tank Nos. 19 & 20 Conversion Project (REO-0208) and authorize the General Manager to sign a construction contract with Paso Robles Tank, Inc., in the amount of \$5,615,199.

Fiscal Impact: The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred during FY 22 and FY 23 with the annual amounts unknown at this time, but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$5,615,199. The costs are included in the Water Funds FY 22 CIP budget and financial projections for FY 23.
