13 YEARS COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY OF

15 THE CANDIDATES TO BE VOTED ON; AND ADOPTING  
16 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE TRANSLATIONS OF

20 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, by Resolution No.  
21 RES-13-0103, duly called and provided for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election  
22 on Tuesday, April 8, 2014; and

23 WHEREAS, the Primary Nominating Election was held in the City of Long  
24 Beach on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, and certain candidates have been nominated for the  
25 office of Mayor, City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and  
26 Councilmember for the Fifth City Council District; and

27 WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, it is necessary for the City  
28 Council to order, proclaim and call a General Municipal Election for the election of Mayor,

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1 City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and Councilmember for  
2 the Fifth City Council District;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
4 follows:

5 Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the  
6 State of California and the provisions of the Charter of the City of Long Beach governing  
7 the holding of municipal elections, a General Municipal Election is ordered, proclaimed  
8 and called to be held in the City of Long Beach, California, between the hours of 7:00  
9 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the 3rd day of June, 2014, for the purpose of electing a Mayor,  
10 City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and Councilmember of  
11 the Fifth City Council District for a full term of four (4) years, commencing with the third  
12 Tuesday of July, 2014.

13 Section 2. The following list of candidates which has been regularly  
14 certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the  
15 office of Mayor, City Attorney, Member of the City Council for the First Council District,  
16 and Member of the City Council for the Fifth Council District, and is in the order of the  
17 randomized alphabet selected by the Secretary of State:

1                   Section 3.    Notice is given of the holding and of the time and place of the  
2 election.

3                   Section 4.    The polls for the General Municipal Election shall be open at  
4 7:00 a.m. and shall be kept open until 8:00 p.m. when the polls shall be closed; except  
5 that, if at the hour of closing there are any voters in the polling place or in line at the door  
6 who are qualified to vote, and who have not been able to do so since appearing, the polls  
7 shall be kept open a sufficient time to enable them to vote; but no one who arrives at the  
8 polling place after 8:00 p.m. shall be entitled to vote, although the polls may be open  
9 when such person arrives.

10                  Section 5.    California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a  
11 candidate's statement must be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further,  
12 in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73)  
13 all candidates' statements for Mayor, City Attorney, Councilmember for the First Council  
14 District, and Councilmember for the Fifth City Council District shall be translated into the  
15 languages indicated: Khmer, Spanish, Tagalog, Korean, and Vietnamese. Any  
16 translations into the required languages shall be available in the City Clerk's office upon  
17 request. A candidate shall not be required to pay for the cost of translating his or her  
18 candidate's statement into any foreign language required pursuant to federal and/or state  
19 law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay to the cost of printing the candidate's  
20 statement in the sample ballot pamphlet in a foreign language.

21                  Section 6.    Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a  
22 charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statements  
23 sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement  
24 the charge for the costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing any candidate  
25 statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or  
26 inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in  
27 accordance with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309, and in such instances  
28 the candidate's statement shall only be published in the English language.

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Section 7. No candidate will be permitted to include any additional materials in any sample ballot package.

Section 8. The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative with a copy of this resolution.

Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
