A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH ORDERING, PROCLAIMING,
CALLING, GIVING NOTICE OF AND PROVIDING FOR

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, by Resolution No. RES-13-0103, duly called and provided for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, April 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Nominating Election was held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, and certain candidates have been nominated for the office of Mayor, City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and Councilmember for the Fifth City Council District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, it is necessary for the City Council to order, proclaim and call a General Municipal Election for the election of Mayor,

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City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and Councilmember for the Fifth City Council District;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the Section 1. State of California and the provisions of the Charter of the City of Long Beach governing the holding of municipal elections, a General Municipal Election is ordered, proclaimed and called to be held in the City of Long Beach, California, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the 3rd day of June, 2014, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, City Attorney, Councilmember for the First City Council District, and Councilmember of the Fifth City Council District for a full term of four (4) years, commencing with the third Tuesday of July, 2014.

The following list of candidates which has been regularly Section 2. certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the office of Mayor, City Attorney, Member of the City Council for the First Council District, and Member of the City Council for the Fifth Council District, and is in the order of the randomized alphabet selected by the Secretary of State:

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Section 3. Notice is given of the holding and of the time and place of the election.

The polls for the General Municipal Election shall be open at Section 4. 7:00 a.m. and shall be kept open until 8:00 p.m. when the polls shall be closed; except that, if at the hour of closing there are any voters in the polling place or in line at the door who are qualified to vote, and who have not been able to do so since appearing, the polls shall be kept open a sufficient time to enable them to vote; but no one who arrives at the polling place after 8:00 p.m. shall be entitled to vote, although the polls may be open when such person arrives.

Section 5. California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a candidate's statement must be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further, in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73) all candidates' statements for Mayor, City Attorney, Councilmember for the First Council District, and Councilmember for the Fifth City Council District shall be translated into the languages indicated: Khmer, Spanish, Tagalog, Korean, and Vietnamese. Any translations into the required languages shall be available in the City Clerk's office upon request. A candidate shall not be required to pay for the cost of translating his or her candidate's statement into any foreign language required pursuant to federal and/or state law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay to the cost of printing the candidate's statement in the sample ballot pamphlet in a foreign language.

Section 6. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statements sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement the charge for the costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing any candidate statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in accordance with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309, and in such instances the candidate's statement shall only be published in the English language.
