9 WHEREAS, Californians for Justice (CFJ) is a statewide grassroots
10 organization with a local office in Long Beach; and

11 WHEREAS, CFJ works for justice by organizing and building the power of
12 often marginalized communities, including youth, immigrants, low-income people and
13 communities of color in order to improve their social, economic and political condition;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, CFJ is currently coordinating a statewide campaign for Quality
16 Education; and

17 WHEREAS, the CFJ campaign is organizing a "Day of Action" on Thursday,
18 May 15, 2008 in which thousands of students, parents, community advocates, and
19 supporters will converge on Sacramento to advocate that the Governor keep his promise
20 to make 2008 the "Year of Education" by fully funding education;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
22 follows:

23 Section 1. To declare May 15th as a "Day of Action" dedicated to
24 advocating for a state budget that supports quality public schools.

25 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
26 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
