HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Ordinance amending Long Beach Municipal Code Section 1.27.010, School Board Districts established; declaring the urgency thereof; and declaring that this ordinance shall take effect immediately. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

In order to implement district boundaries for the Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) as required by Federal and State Law, the Council must adopt an ordinance to redistrict boundaries based on the 2020 United States Census. Note that LBUSD is not subject to the requirements of Charter section 2500 et seq. (Measure DDD), and is instead required to follow City Charter Section 2202.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy Attorney Amy Webber on November 29, 2021 and by Budget Operations and Development Officer Rhutu Amin Gharib on December 1, 2021.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

Approval of the foregoing recommendation will permit the City Clerk Department to forward new boundary details to the Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder by their deadline of December 31, 2021. for purposes of planning the June 2022 Primary Nomination Election (PNE). This action contains an urgency clause in order to permit compliance with this deadline.

FISCAL IMPACT

The requested action has no fiscal impact and is giving notice to the City Council on the Long Beach Unified School District boundaries based on the 2020 United States Census. This recommendation has no staffing impact beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and is consistent with existing City Council priorities. There is no local job impact associated with this recommendation.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 1.27.010 SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED; DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF; AND DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.27.010 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.27.010 Districts established.

In accordance with Section 2202(a) of the Long Beach City Charter, the five (5) school board districts for the board of education of the Long Beach Unified School District (hereinafter "school district") are established and designated as follows:

5	the City Council by a vote of five of its members and shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on
6	December 7, 2021. The City Clerk shall certify to a separate roll call and vote on the
7	question of the emergency of this ordinance and to its passage by the vote of five
8	members of the City Council of the City of Long Beach, and cause the same to be posted
9	in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.

11	Section 3. This ordinance shall also be adopted by the City Council as a
12	regular ordinance, to the end that in the event of any defect or invalidity in connection
13	with the adoption of this ordinance as an emergency ordinance, the same shall,
14	nevertheless, be and become effective on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by
15	the Mayor. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City
16	Council of the City of Long Beach and shall cause the same to be posted in three (3)
17	conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.

AUTHORIZED DEC - 1 2021 BY BOARD ACTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT RECOMMENDING NEW BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICTS FOR THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO TAKE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, following each decennial census, population data within the Long Beach Unified School District must be reviewed to determine whether Board of Education Districts must be adjusted to continue compliance with applicable Federal and State Constitutional requirements and Voting Rights Act Laws; and

WHEREAS, when the population variance between the least populous and most populous Board of Education Districts exceeds 10% of the ideal board area size, adjustments to boundaries must be made in order to bring the Board Districts within the allowable variance for the next applicable election; and

WHEREAS, the population variance reflected in the latest decennial census indicated the need to redraw Board of Education boundaries:

WHEREAS, the District engaged in extensive outreach efforts, including the development of a redistricting website, to provide information on the redistricting process for the public and to solicit public input on proposed new boundaries; and

WHEREAS, as a result of community input from the Communities of Interest Survey, three proposed maps have been prepared for the public and Board of Education consideration;

WHEREAS, the proposed maps have been reviewed for compliance with applicable Federal and State Constitutional requirements and Voting Rights Acts laws prior to presentation to the public and Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, such maps have been presented on October 20, 2021 for Board of Education and community input; and

WHEREAS, the District sought the community's input on the proposed maps through community meetings, community events, and other engagement activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of the Long Beach Unified School District resolves as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Education approves for recommendation to the City of Long Beach the Board of Education Districts attached hereto in Exhibit "A" and as described in the written description attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

Section 2. The Board of Education directs District staff to submit the recommended map and Board of Education District descriptions to the City of Long Beach for approval and submission to the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder.

Section 3. The Board of Education directs District staff to work with the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder, as needed, in implementing the new Districts for use in the June 2022 and future District elections.

The foregoing resolution was considered, passed, and adopted by this Board at its regular meeting of December 1, 2021.


