Executive Summary

Bids for Specification WD-15-22 to furnish and deliver Sodium Hypochlorite, a water treatment chemical used at J. Will Johnson Reservoir were opened on December 3, 2021. It was determined that the bid submitted by JCI Jones Chemicals Inc. conforms to all bid document requirements and is the lowest responsive bidder. JCI Jones Chemicals Inc. is our current supplier of Sodium Hypochlorite to LBWD and is meeting performance specifications.

Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-15-22 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals Inc., to furnish and deliver Sodium Hypochlorite (5.25% Solution) in an amount not to exceed \$10,375 for a period of six months.

Fiscal Impact: The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred during FY22, with the actual amounts unknown at this time but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$10,375 for the contract term. These costs are included in the FY22 budget.
