### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive the application of Chateau Hospitality Collection, Incorporated, dba Bacchus Manor, for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license, at 743 East Fourth Street; submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC and, direct the City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit Exemption (CUPEX) is granted. (District 1)

### **DISCUSSION**

It is City Council policy to review applications for ABC licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.

### TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control received the above application on December 8, 2021. The applicant is still in the planning stages and has not yet received a CUPEX. Provided the Planning Commission approves the CUPEX, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest. City Council action is requested on January 18, 2022, to respond to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control by the January 26, 2022 due date.
