

Proposed Sunrise of Long Beach – Site Plan



- Services provided include personalized elderly care, supportive 24-hour assistance with ADLs, Alzheimer's and memory care (as necessary), food and restaurant quality dining, housekeeping and laundry, transportation, programs and activities for daily physical fitness, creative, social, learning and spiritual opportunities and medication coordination.
- The project will annually employ approximately 100 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Staff Members with a maximum of 30 employees on site at any given time:

- 3:00PM 11:00PM (approx. 25 employees 25% depart after dinner and another 25% depart after residents settled in rooms)
