	19	WHEREAS, the cyber security assessment will identify these vulnerabilities
	20	and suggest solutions to remediate information technology security defense gaps and
	21	ensure compliance with National Institute of Standards and Technology regulations; and
	22	WHEREAS, the Police Department researched procurement options for
	23	public safety and emergency preparedness equipment and related services and
	24	discovered other agencies had completed an open, fair, transparent, and competitive
	25	procurement process; and
	26	WHEREAS, the City reviewed the contract options and determined that the
	27	contract between the County of Fairfax, Virginia, with Mallory Safety and Supply, LLC

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WHEREAS, Mallory Safety and Supply, LLC has partnered with Clear 1 2 Cloud Solutions, Inc. to provide the technical expertise to complete the requested cyber 3 security assessment for the Long Beach Police Department; and 4 WHEREAS, Clear Cloud Solution's approach is founded on their highly 5 relevant project experience, successful past performance and expertise in delivering 6 similar security systems for local Government; and 7 WHEREAS, Clear Cloud Solution's team of industry experts possess a vast 8 knowledge of security planning, system design, engineering, and system integration; and 9 WHEREAS, the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant program 10 provides financial assistance to address the unique multidisciplinary planning, operations 11 equipment, training and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density, urban areas, as well 12 as assists in building and sustaining capabilities to prevent, protect against, respond to, 13 and recover from threats or acts of terrorism; and 14 WHEREAS, the UASI 2020 grant program will fund this vital cyber security 15 assessment as part of the grant awarded to the City of Long Beach on May 4, 2021; and 16 WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, Virginia has a CONTRACT for the 17 purchase of a cyber security assessment, Contract No. 4400008495 ("Fairfax Contract"); 18 and 19 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Fairfax Contract will facilitate the 20 City's ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and 21 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the Fairfax Contract considerably more funds would be required; 22 23 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as 24 follows: 25 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated 26 herein by this reference. 27 The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter Section 2. 28 an agreement with Mallory Safety and Supply, LLC to purchase a cyber security 2

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assessment, of the same type and kind identified in the County of Fairfax, Virginia 1 2 Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Mallory Safety and 3 Supply, LLC and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions 4 afforded to the County of Fairfax, Virginia in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Sixty-Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$160,933), until the County of 5 6 Fairfax, Virginia, contract expires on September 30, 2023, with the option to renew for as 7 long as the County of Fairfax, Virginia Contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City 8 Manager.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption 9 Section 3. 10 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
