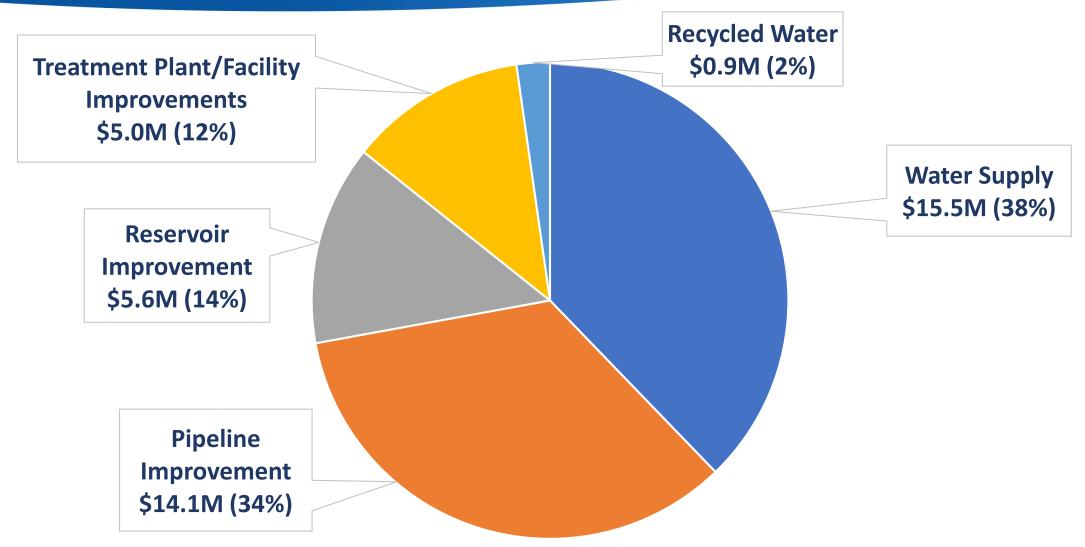

 - > 5% MWD increase in FY 23 and FY 24
 - > 4% WRD increase in FY 23
- Buffer for (emergency) capital expense costs
- Rate stabilization

5-Yr Sewer Fund Projected Ending Reserves (No FY 23 Sewer rate increase)

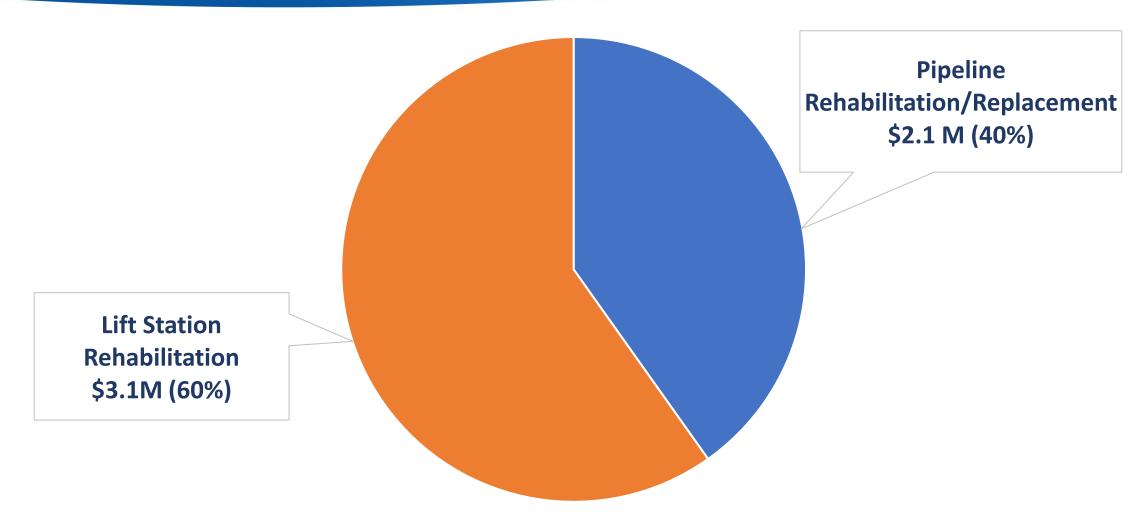

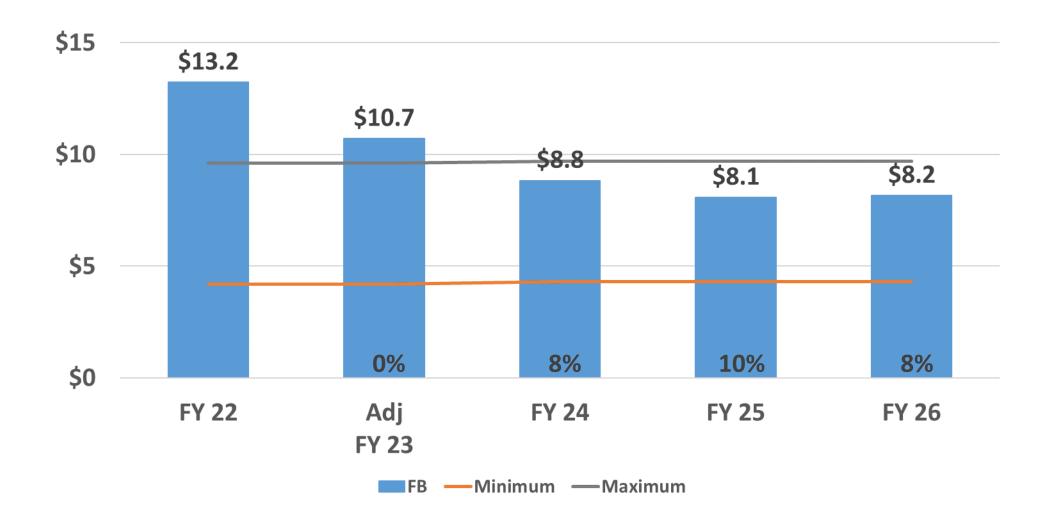

5-Yr Sewer Fund Projected Ending Reserves (No FY 23 Sewer rate increase)

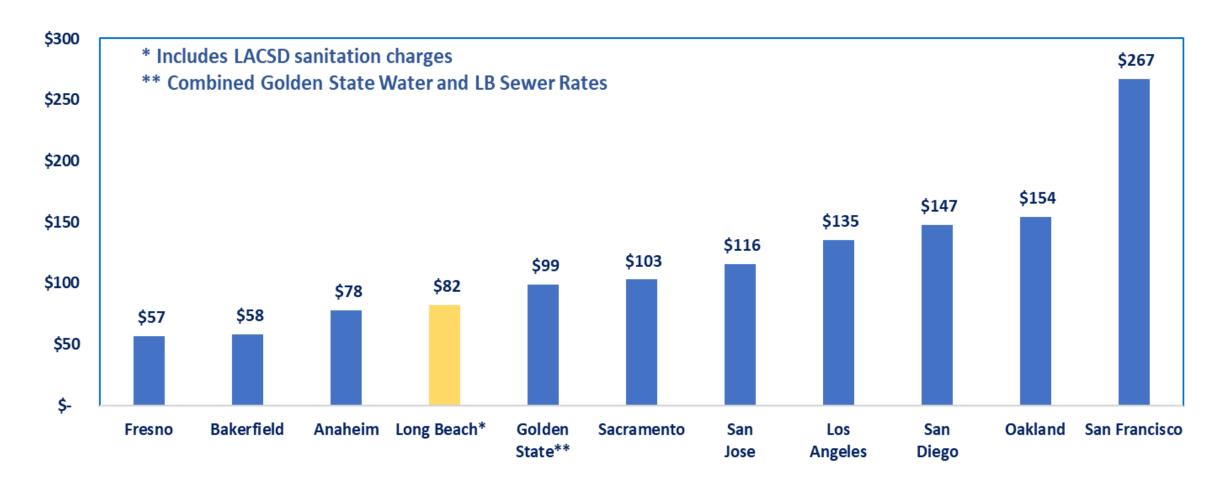
