HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the public hearing, and grant an Entertainment Permit with conditions for entertainment with dancing to House of Pain INC, dba The Bird, at 1253 E. 4th Street. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit (Permit) is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires the City Council to approve the issuance of the Permit if they find that: the issuance of the Permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) nor any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City of Long Beach (City) code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: (1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or (2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Financial Management Department every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke, or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application, and floor plan.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the Permit for entertainment with dancing be approved, subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

• The Development Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Financial Management Department, Business Services Bureau, has thoroughly reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and recommends the Permit for entertainment with dancing be approved subject to conditions (Attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee must adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Bar, Tavern, Lounge since May 2021.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Arturo D. Sanchez on June 1, 2022.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of June 21, 2022, has been posted at the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$23.30 and Zoning Review \$33.00 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,483.00 (Police Department), and Mailing List \$90.00 and Temporary Entertainment Permit Fee \$454.00 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License Annual Tax \$397.04, Employee Rate \$20.62 per employee and Annual Entertainment Regulatory Fee \$352.00 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation House of Pain INC dba The Bird 1253 East 4th Street, Long Beach, CA 90802 Application for Entertainment With Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80). In addition, in response to a complaint, the Police Department will enforce Penal Code Section 415 (disturbing the peace) and all other state and local provisions related to the "public peace." Permittee shall conduct all aspects of his or her operation, including before and after-hours deliveries and maintenance, in consideration of residences located nearby. Permittee agrees that the following standard is reasonable: Noise emanating from Permittee's premises shall not be audible from the middle of the street adjoining the premises.
- 4) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 5) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.
- 6) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 7) During all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted, the permittee shall provide an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1)

uniformed security guard. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 9) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the front of the establishment, the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 10) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 11) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 12) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 13) The Bird, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 14) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- 15) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas



within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.

- 16) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety-day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be kept on file at the business and shall be available for inspection at any time.
- 17) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 18) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment at the start and during entertainment activities for the sole purpose of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver license or identification card.

II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- Entertainment activities indicated on your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 11:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 AM Thursday through Sunday. Entertainment can begin at 6:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 PM Thursday through Sunday.
- 2) The permittee is required to monitor the outside patio area for any nuisance activity that could disturb the surrounding neighbors. This shall be done by utilizing security guards or employees.
- 3) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- 4) The permittee shall develop and maintain a plan to address neighborhood concerns, related to the operation of the establishment. (i.e. newsletter, meetings, etc.)
- 5) The permittee and/or security shall also ensure that no employee, patron, or entertainer loiters in the parking lot at any time during the operation of the business.

The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit and loiter near the side or rear doors leading to the alley or adjacent building not in the control of the business.



- 6) The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
- 7) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 8) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 9) Entertainment shall not be offered on any day that the bar/nightclub is closed.
- 10) Patrons awaiting entry in a defined "queue" shall be restricted to 4th Street and the line must extend in safe manner of the business. There shall be no "queue" allowed after 11:00 PM, Monday through Wednesday nights and 12:00 AM Thursday through Sunday nights. All persons gathering outside after the allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. The public right of way (sidewalk), or an entrance to any business shall not be blocked at any time.
- III. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license is in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. In addition, please be advised that your permit is subject to administrative review every two years from the date this permit is issued. If grounds exist for modification, revocation, or suspension of the permit, a hearing will be held.







Security Plan: The first line of defense is the doorperson(s)/security personnel

• Entrances: Doorman must be stationed at the front door opening or just inside the front door where the bar and the entrance are clearly visible.

- ID's: ID checks and capacity counts at the entrance are required. Only official hard copy driver's licenses or passports are to be accepted as identification. No other forms of ID, paper printouts etc. should be accepted or used. This is a must!
- Flashlights: All doorman and or guards should always have a small / medium tactical flashlight on their person as well as a working cell phone. The flashlight should be used when checking ID's, moving crowds or hailing the attention of other staff when needed. This is a must!
- Bathroom / Smoke Breaks: If a bathroom or smoke break is needed the doorman should request the bar back come to the front door and maintain the entrance while the break is being taken or the second doorman if one is available. You should never ask a patron to watch the door for you unless it's an absolute emergency and should only be done until the bar back or another employee of the bar can take over.
- Picking up bottles and glasses: This should be done whenever possible in order to assist the bar staff during slow times as long as it does not pose an issue in securing the entrance of the establishment. Once it's determined that it's busy, the doorman should refrain from picking up bottles and glasses and should solely focus on the entrance and surrounding areas. Once things slow down, the doorman should resume assisting the bar staff in picking up bottles and glasses if possible.
- Bag Checks: All backpacks and large tote style purses should be checked if suspicion the person or people could possibly be bringing in alcohol from the outside. You would notice this by the look and weight of the bag the person is carrying. Simply explain to the patron that you would like them to open their bag From you to confirm there are no alcoholic beverages or weapons being brought in. Make sure to ask them to move the contents around in the bag as needed and you should never put your hands inside of the bags or touch their property. Use your flashlight to see what is in there and decide if the bag is free of these items. Again, do not put your hands in the bags or touch their property. If you find contents that are not allowed, simply ask them to take them out to their car and re-enter the establishment. If it becomes an issue and they do not want to

show you their bag, you have the authority per the owner to reject them from entering the establishment. This goes for regulars as well.

Interaction with Patrons:

- ~Treat all patrons with respect, always.
- ~ You should be greeting people and opening the door for them whenever possible.
- ~Use good eye contact always
- ~ Thank them for coming to the establishment and have a good night etc.
- ~ Make them feel comfortable.
- ~ Never intimidate
- ~ Build rapport with patrons wherever possible, you may need their assistance later

Crowd Control:

- "Crowd control as needed with the right approach.
- "Request all patrons lingering in front of the businesses in the immediate area of the bar entrance to move back in front of the bar or back inside if possible. We do not want large crowds of people hanging out in front of these businesses talking loud or smoking.
- "Do not push people or yell profanities at people to get them to comply, maintain respectful communication and composure at all times.

Dealing with or Encountering Unruly Individuals:

If there is a situation and you need to eject someone from the establishment:

- ~ Stay calm and talk them through the process more than you might feel is necessary, give them the benefit of the doubt unless the situation is clear.
- ~ Use your flashlight and cell phone to request backup or call the police if needed. Flag down the nearest person or patron to go get someone.
- ~ Additional backup should be used for crowd control if needed.
- ~ Be polite, firm and respectful regardless of how the person may act or what they may say.
- ~ Allow them to walk out of the establishment on their own accord with you in support.
- ~ If they refuse to leave, encircle them and do your best to remove them from the establishment, it's the establishments right to refuse service to anyone they choose,

especially if they are acting unruly. If needed, detain them and call PD to have them removed and cited for trespassing. Usually they will get it and decide to leave of which you let them.

Use of Force

- ~ Reasonable or rational force is that amount of force necessary to defend oneself, and defend others, and to control a potentially violent situation. It is excessive only if it is not necessary. Fear by itself is not justification for using force or being threatening in any manner. Should force be needed to make a citizen's arrest or defend oneself, use only the amount of force that is reasonable to stop the actions of the adversary.
- ~ You are only allowed to use force when necessary to defend yourself or a team member/patron. If you reasonably believe that an attack upon another would result in great bodily injury, the person may use force reasonably necessary to repel the attack or assault.
- "Make sure your backup is your witness and make sure that an incident report is filed with Sam William and charges are made against the individual in the altercation to protect yourself and the company.
- ~ You must use good judgement of a reasonable person always.
- ~ Handcuffs should never be used unless you have been qualified through the appropriate training. Using them without training and certification could result in a liability situation for the establishment and the company.

The second line of defense, for The Bird, are its bartenders. They are trained to identify patrons who are or becoming intoxicated and/or causing disturbances. They are trained in non confrontational methods to cut such patrons off from further drinking and to alert the doormen/security of such action.

Emergency

- ~ Assess the situation
- ~ Call your supervisor on the radio or cell phone, communicate with bar staff.
- ~ Determine if PD or FD are needed
- ~Call 911
- When in doubt, follow POST orders

End of Night "Last Call"

1:30am Last Call

- 1:40am All entertainment is terminated and all house lights are turned up
- 1:45 am All remaining patrons are asked to leave through the exit doors and vacate premises
- 1:50 am All alcoholic beverages are cleared off of the floor, bar, tables

Subject: APPLICATION FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT WITH DANCING PERMIT AT THE

BIRD - 1253 EAST 4TH STREET

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above-named permit application for Entertainment <u>with</u> Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following standard conditions of operation.

The Bird is a local bar and nightclub that offers alcoholic beverages, beer, wine and distilled spirits. The Bird showcases a variety of events and entertainment events. The establishment is located in the 1200 block of East 4th Street, on the northside of the street. The current owner for the business is House of Pain, Incorporated. The Bird has a valid Type 48 (On-Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control License. This is a new application for the ownership.

The Bird applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit requesting dancing by patrons, guests, customers, participants and attendees, live music by more than two (2) performers, live and recorded amplified music, a disc jockey and karaoke. They requested to provide entertainment from 6:00 PM to 1:00 AM, Monday through Wednesday and 9:00 AM to 1:00 AM, Thursday through Sunday.

The Police Department is recommending entertainment activities shall be restricted to no later than 11:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 AM Thursday through Sunday. Entertainment can begin at 6:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 PM Thursday through Sunday.

Based upon the Police Department's Investigation, The South Division Acting Patrol Commander's recommendation, and the crime analysis, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.

- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 11:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 AM Thursday through Sunday. Entertainment can begin at 6:00 PM Monday through Wednesday and 12:00 PM Thursday through Sunday.
- 4) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
- 5) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment at the start and during entertainment activities for the sole purpose of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver license or identification card.
- 6) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations
- The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-way's and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and username/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras
- 8) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 9) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 10) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class, such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employees' proof of completion on file and have it available for inspection at any time.

- 11) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 12) The permittee is required to monitor the outside patio area for any nuisance activity that could disturb the surrounding neighbors. This shall be done by utilizing security guards or employees.
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operation give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premise or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 14) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times, while open for business. This should be done by utilizing security guards and signage with verbiage such as, "Please respect our neighbors," or something similar.
- 15) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- The Bird, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, any vehicle, or in any other such place in the City of Long Beach. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 17) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate neighboring area.
- 18) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

- 19) The permittee shall develop and maintain a plan to address neighborhood concerns, related to the operation of the establishment. (i.e. newsletter, meetings, etc.)
- 20) The permittee shall comply with the requirements of LBMC Sec. 8.80 (Noise) at all times. In addition, in response to a complaint, the Police Department will enforce Penal Code Section 415 (disturbing the peace) and all other state and local provisions related to the "public peace." Permittee shall conduct all aspects of his or her operation, including before and after-hours deliveries and maintenance, in consideration of residences located nearby. Permittee agrees that the following standard is reasonable: Noise emanating from Permittee's premises shall not be audible from the middle of the street adjoining the premises.

Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.

21) The permittee and/or security shall also ensure that no employee, patron, or entertainer loiters in the parking lot at any time during the operation of the business.

The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit and loiter near the side or rear doors leading to the alley or adjacent building not in the control of the business.

- The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
- No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 24) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 25) Entertainment shall not be offered on any day that the bar/nightclub is closed.
- Patrons awaiting entry in a defined "queue" shall be restricted to 4th Street and the line must extend in safe manner of the business. There shall be no "queue" allowed after 11:00 PM, Monday through Wednesday nights and 12:00 AM Thursday through Sunday nights. All persons gathering outside after the allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. The public right of way (sidewalk), or an entrance to any business shall not be blocked at any time.
