3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT  
6 WITH SHI INTERNATIONAL, CORP., FOR THE PURCHASE  
7 OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, PARTS AND RELATED  
8 PRODUCTS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS  
9 AFFORDED TO THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA THROUGH  
10 OMNIA PARTNERS, PUBLIC SECTOR, IN AN ANNUAL  
11 AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000, UNTIL  
12 THE OMNIA CONTRACT EXPIRES ON FEBRUARY 28,  
13 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS  
14 THE OMNIA CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE  
15 DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

17 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the  
18 City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without  
19 advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other  
20 government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

21 WHEREAS, the City requires computer equipment, parts and related  
22 products; and

23 WHEREAS, the City of Mesa, Arizona through Omnia Partners, Public  
24 Sector, has a contract with SHI International, Corp. for information technology solutions,  
25 and services, Contract No. 2018011 ("Omnia Contract"); and

26 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Omnia Contract will facilitate timely  
27 acquisition of the computer equipment, parts and related products as well as provide  
28 considerable cost benefits to the City; and
