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RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0098

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH STRICTLY TECHNOLOGY LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, PARTS AND RELATED PRODUCTS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS), IN AN ANNUAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000, UNTIL THE TIPS CONTRACT EXPIRES ON MAY 31, 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE TIPS CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City requires computer equipment, parts and related products; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS), has a contract with Strictly Technology LLC. for technology solutions, products, and services, Contract No. 200105 ("TIPS Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the TIPS Contract will facilitate timely acquisition of the computer equipment, parts and related products as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and
