Executive Summary

Bids for Specification WD-39-22 to furnish and deliver ductile iron pipe, fittings for ductile iron pipe, and related materials were opened on May 17, 2022. Two bids were received and evaluated. Core & Main was deemed to be the lowest responsive bidder and the bid document conformed to all specification requirements.

Recommendation

Adopt Specification WD-39-22 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with Core & Main to furnish and deliver ductile iron pipe, fittings for ductile iron pipe, and related materials to the Long Beach Water Department in an amount not to exceed \$1,850,000 for a six-month period.

Fiscal Impact: The total FY 22 cost of the contract to the Water Fund will not exceed \$1,850,000. These costs are included in the Water Fund FY 22 Budget and financial projections.
