Increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$1,701.15, offset by the Third Council District One-time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide a contribution to the Friends of Belmont Shore for their Annual Community Concert scheduled for August 11, 2022; and,

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$1,701.15 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.
