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# RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS **ANGELES** TO **AUTHORIZE** AND ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF Α STATEWIDE **GENERAL** MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR FOUR CHARTER AMENDMENTS WITH THE STATEWIDE **GENERAL** ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022; REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF SAID GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE CITY WILL PAY TO THE COUNTY REASONABLE AND ACTUAL EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE COUNTY ON ACCOUNT OF THE CONSOLIDATION OF THIS ELECTION

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2022, the City Council of the City of Long Beach called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2022 for the purpose of submitting to the voters the following proposed charter amendment(s) to be voted upon:

- A. Amendment to the Long Beach City Charter to realign the City's primary election date with the State's primary and general election dates held in even-numbered years;
- B. Amendment to the Long Beach City Charter to realign
  LBUSD's primary election date with the State's primary and general election
  dates held in even-numbered years;

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- C. Amendment to the Long Beach City Charter to establish a Police Oversight Commission and add a Director of Police Oversight position;
- D. Amendment to the Long Beach City Charter for consolidation of the City's existing water, sewer and gas utilities into a single publiclyowned utility, governed by the existing independent Water/Public Utilities Commission, for the purposes of improving customer service through better coordination of street pipeline and infrastructure repairs; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this General Municipal Election for the above city charter amendment(s) be consolidated with the statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that the precincts, polling places and election officers for all the elections be the same within the City and that the County of Los Angeles canvass the returns of this General Municipal Election and that the statewide General Election and the General Municipal Election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of these elections, it will be necessary to mail sample ballots and polling place information to the registered voters of the City, and it will facilitate such mailing if the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles will make available to the City the computer record of the names and addresses of all eligible registered voters in order that labels may be printed for attaching to self-mailer sample ballot pamphlets; and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service shall be paid by the City of Long Beach;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the California Elections Code, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is requested to authorize and order the consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the statewide General Election to be held in the State of California on November 8, 2022,

for the purpose of submitting the following charter amendment(s) to Long Beach voters:

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors is authorized and further requested by the City Council to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election or to cause the returns to be canvassed by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, all as prescribed in the Elections Code. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one

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election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. Pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10403 and 10418, the election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the Statewide General Election.

Section 3. The City Council determines and declares that the City will pay to the County the reasonable and actual expenses incurred by the County by the consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the statewide General Election. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is authorized and directed to pay for the expenses incurred after receiving a statement from the County of Los Angeles.

Section 4. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to provide all services necessary for the lawful and effective conduct of the General election to be held on November 8, 2022, and make available to the City additional assistance according to state law.

Section 5. That the City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

Section 6. That the City Clerk is authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, along with a copy of the resolution calling the General Municipal Election.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
