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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE TERMINIX INTERNATIONAL LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, **FOR** PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS AND SERVICES, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS, IN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000, UNTIL THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA CONTRACT EXPIRES ON APRIL 8, 2026, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASK CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT. AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY **MANAGER**

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City requires pest control products and services; and WHEREAS, the University of Nebraska through Omnia Partners, has a contract with The Terminix International Company Limited Partnership for pest control products and services, Contract No. 3280-20-7210-01 ("University of Nebraska Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the University of Nebraska Contract will facilitate timely acquisition of the pest control products and services as well as provide

considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the University of Nebraska Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with The Terminix International Company Limited Partnership for pest control products and services, of the same kind identified in the University of Nebraska Contract in an annual amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), until University of Nebraska Contract No. 3280-20-7210-01 expires on April 8, 2026, with the option to renew for as long as University of Nebraska Contract No. 3280-20-7210-01 is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
