Expenditure Status Update

- Mid-year adjustments include:
 - \$0.8 million adjustment approved by City Council for approved projects that were not fully expended in FY 21 to be carried over to FY 22
 - \$9.96 million add for key priority projects identified by the City Council as part of the FY 22 budget adoption and other priority projects
 - \$11.7 million set aside for out-year plan in result of the alignment of the debt service payments for the Motorola Public Safety Radios to a multiyear amortization schedule
 - Measure B Stabilization Fund projection increased to approximately \$0.8 million to reflect revenue projection increase

Revenues Status Update

- The Adopted FY 22 Budget projected revenue to recover and more closely align to pre-pandemic levels in FY 22
- Revenues based on two quarters of activity covering October through March total \$41.8 million
- These revenues are showing a trend of better performance than budgeted, estimating to end the year at \$81.9 million, close to \$13 million higher than budgeted and significantly exceeding pre-pandemic levels
- Improvements across various categories including restaurants, hotels, and general consumer goods, unanticipated price increases in automobiles and fuel, and one-time use tax revenues from development projects in the City

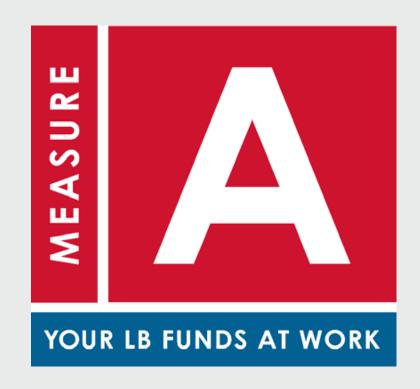
