Executive Summary

Bids for Specification WD-22-005 to provide maintenance and repair service for existing Hach equipment and to upgrade existing instrument on an as-needed basis were opened on August 25, 2022. One proposal from Hach Company was received and evaluated and it was deemed to conform to all specification requirements.

Recommendation

Adopt Specification WD-22-005 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with Hach Company to provide maintenance and repair service for existing Hach equipment and upgrade existing online instrument on an as-needed basis in an amount not to exceed \$153,000 for a one-year period and to exercise the options to renew for two additional one-year periods, subject to a maximum increase of 10% for each renewal period.

Fiscal Impact: The total FY 23 cost of the contract to the Water Fund will not exceed \$153,000. These costs are included in the Water Fund FY 23 Budget and financial projections.
