Completed Projects

Key Highlights

- 38 park playgrounds, community centers, and park facility projects completed;
- Nearly 640 lane miles of streets repaired;
- Over 8.9 miles of alleys rehabilitated, of which 5.23 miles were formerly dirt;
- Over 1,480,800 sq. ft. of sidewalks replaced and over 2,740 curb ramps replaced;
- 22 Public Facility projects completed, including:
 - 4 fire station projects,
 - 5 health and public safety projects, and
 - 10 library projects.

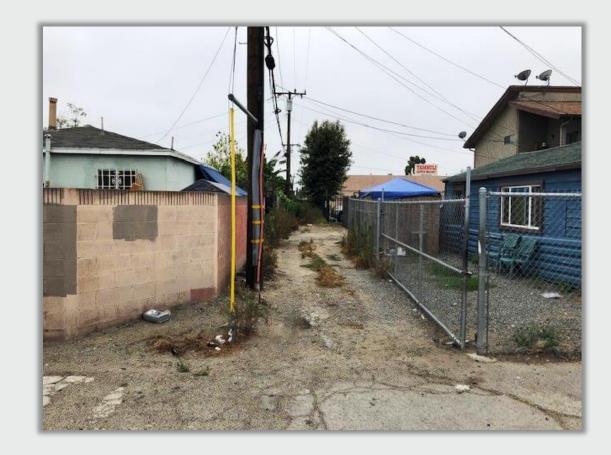

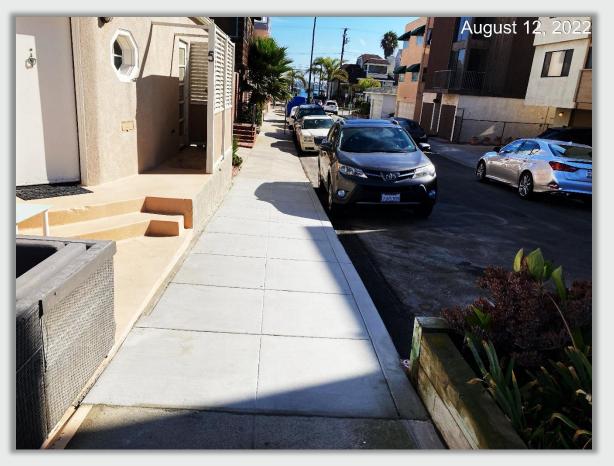

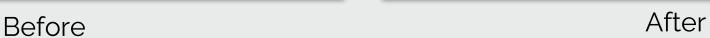

Parks and Recreation	
Cal Rec / McBride Park Community Center Roof	\$500K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund roof improvements.
El Dorado Artificial Field Turf	\$400K from completed El Dorado Field Turf to El Dorado Duck Pond Rehab project.
Recreation Park Playground	\$200K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund playground.
Wardlow Park ADA Restrooms	\$200K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund improvements.
Wardlow Park Community Center Roof	\$350K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund roof improvements.
Public Facilities	
El Dorado Library	\$400K from El Dorado Library to El Dorado Duck Pond.
Facility Condition Assessment (FCA)	Transferred remaining FCA budget to Critical Infrastructure Reserve to fund projects identified by the FCA.
Fire Station 1 Roof	\$400K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund critical repairs at Fire Station 1 for roof rehabilitation.
Main Health Emergency Generator	Transferred \$350K from Main Health Improvement project to Main Health Emergency Generator project. This now includes a fire suppression system valve upgrade and exterior lighting bulb/globe replacement.
Police North Division Roof Repair	\$560K from Critical Infrastructure Reserves to fund roof improvements.
