RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution and approve the proposed Fiscal Year 2023 (FY 23) General Park Mid-Year fee changes and make such changes effective November 18, 2022.

DISCUSSION

On November 1, 2022, the City Council approved a recommendation to request the City Manager to review a proposal to consider a Veteran's Annual Vehicle Park Pass fee discount at El Dorado East Regional Park; the agenda item was approved.

On November 10, 2022, the Finance and Appeals Subcommittee reviewed and approved the proposed Fiscal Year 2023 General Park Mid-Year fee changes for parks and recreation programs. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine (Department) fees established by the Parks and Recreation Commission (Commission) are intended to recover the costs associated with providing the service to individuals and organizations for activities that are consistent with the Department's Mission and Vision.

The attached list includes proposed adjustments to Department fees to provide cost recovery for user fees consistent with Commission policy. A complete listing of the proposed changes is attached for review (Attachment A). The recommended changes will be effective November 18, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT

Since this is a newly implemented discount for veterans, staff cannot estimate the annual revenue changes accrued to the General Fund Group in an effort to achieve cost recovery for providing these services.
