

RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0183

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION
FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE SAN GABRIEL AND
LOWER LOS ANGELES RIVERS AND MOUNTAINS
CONSERVANCY CLIMATE RESILIENCE GRANT
PROGRAM, FOR THE COLORADO LAGOON PROJECT

WHEREAS, the State of California has authorized an expenditure of General
Funds by the San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles Rivers and Mountains Conservancy
(RMC) for the Climate Resilience Grant Program in Section 69 of Senate Bill 170, known
as the Budget Act of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the RMC has been delegated the responsibility for the
administration of the grant program in its jurisdiction, setting up necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the RMC require the Applicant's
Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the Application before submission
of said Application to the State; and

WHEREAS, City desires submit a grant application to Rivers and Mountains
Conservancy for the Climate Resilience Grant Program for the Colorado Lagoon Project
(Project); and

WHEREAS, if awarded, City intends to accept an amount up to \$1,500,000
for completion of the Colorado Lagoon Project and authorizes the City Manager, or
designee, to execute all documents necessary to accept the funds and implement the
project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach approves the filing

1 of an Application for Grant Funds from the RMC Climate Resilience Grant Program and
2 certifies as follows:

3 A. That the San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles Rivers and
4 Mountains Conservancy Climate Resilience Grant Program, for the Colorado
5 Lagoon Project (Project”) is consistent with local or regional land use plans
6 or Programs; and

7 B. That the Project is consistent with the goals of Climate
8 Resilience Grant Program including multi-beneficial and multi-jurisdictional
9 ecosystem and watershed protection projects in accordance with statewide
10 priorities; and

11 C. That the Application has or will have sufficient funds to operate
12 and maintain the Project that is being submitted for funding consideration;
13 and

14 D. That the Applicant has reviewed and understands the General
15 Requirements and General Policies of the RMC Grant Program Guidelines;
16 and

17 Section 2. The City Council of the City of Long Beach appoints the City
18 Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute, and submit all
19 documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and
20 so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.

21 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
