## Subject

Adopt Specifications WD-23-043 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals Inc., to furnish and deliver Liquid Chlorine in an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for a period of six months.

## **Executive Summary**

Bids for Specification WD-23-043 to furnish and deliver Liquid Chlorine, a water treatment chemical used at Long Beach Ground Water Treatment Plant, were opened on January 6, 2023. Two vendors submitted bids at the same price. After consultation with the City Attorney's office, it was determined that the bid submitted by JCI Jones was more financially beneficial to the Department by avoiding the need to coordinate switching out vendor hardware. JCI Jones conforms to all bid document requirements and is the current chlorine chemical supplier meeting all performance specifications.

#### Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-23-043 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals Inc., to furnish and deliver Liquid Chlorine in an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for a period of six months.

**Fiscal Impact:** The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred in FY 23, with the actual amounts unknown at this time but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$600,000 for the contract term. These costs are included in the Water Fund FY 23 Budget and financial projections.
