

- COLB Needs Indemnification Agreement to be signed before putting humans lives in danger.
- 2022 Current Class Action against Cities with Tiny Shed Villages for Homeless. (COLB needs 30 million Dollar Insurance Policy plus Indemnification forms preventing Class Action lawsuits that WILL Happen)!
 - 1. Class v. San Antonio (City sued NOT classified as a TINY HOME)
 - 2. Valentini vs Shineso et al. (Veterans are dying from heat, fire et al)
 - 3. Class v. Seattle, Washington (Numerous Homeless have been raped)
 - 4. Class v. Portland, Oregon (Numerous Homeless have been electrocuted)
 - 5. Veterans v. West LA VA (Tiny Homes)
 - 6. Class v. City of Oakland (Tiny Homes)
- No Sprinkler System, No Panic Buttons, No Insulation from excessive Heat and Cold
- 24-7-Armed Security, 24-7 Maintenance Person plus 24-7 Cameras
- No Running Water, No Toilets, NOT classified as a Home per Building Codes (COLB), 100 degrees outside equals 140 degrees inside (Homeless are thrown into Ovens and cooked alive). 300 Tiny Shed residents reported being been raped in 2022, 15 electrocuted, 25 dead by fire or internal organs damaged (excessive heat or cold), cannot get mail directly (Allows 4Class Action)
