Other Locations: The Non-Profit Center	Has not confirmed availability.


Potential Meeting Sites

Location and Address	Notes
Miller Family Health Education Center <i>3820 Cherry Ave, 90807</i>	Prior to 2020, the Miller Family Health Education Center was previously used as the regular meeting location for the Human Relations Commission. On-site parking available, building needs major updates, AV support is needed, rental fee required.
Recreation Park Social Hall <i>4900 E 7th St, 90804</i>	Located in East Long Beach. Unavailable on August 2 nd . AV support is needed.
Ronald R. Arias Health Equity Center <i>6335 Myrtle Ave., 90805</i>	Accommodates 30-35 people. Rental fee required.
Civic Chambers <i>411 Ocean Blvd, 90802</i>	Tech infrastructure can support virtual public participation via Zoom. Parking lot available. AV available. Difficulties with hearing in Chambers.
Energy Resources Auditorium <i>2400 East Spring Street, 90806</i>	Although the auditorium is available, after-hours coverage will be checked at the time the reservation application is submitted for approval. On-site parking available. AV needed. Comfortably accommodates 40 people.
Long Beach City College	Currently working with events manager Jay Lopez to identify a space at either of the campuses: Liberal Arts Campus in Lakewood Village and Pacific Coast Campus in Central LB on PCH. Rental fee required.
