 - should maintain the rate of increase within the last 3 years
 - Measure 2: The Extent to which Persons who Exit Homelessness to Permanent Housing Destinations Return to Homelessness
 - should reduce the rate by 2% of total population
 - o Measure 3: Number of Homeless Persons
 - should reduce the rate of increase within the last 3 years
 - Measure 4: Employment and Income Growth for Homeless Persons in CoC Program-funded Projects
 - should maintain or slightly increase
 - Measure 5: Number of persons who become homeless for the First Time
 - should reduce rate within the last 3 years
 - o Measure 6: N/A
 - Measure 7: Successful Placement from Street Outreach and in or Retention of Permanent Housing
 - Street Outreach should increase 5%

- Will bring this to the CoC Board for review
- Review 2023's PIT Numbers
 - o 2022 was a bit of an anomaly for our unsheltered veterans
 - o First time Homeless and Living in Vehicles increased
 - o Student population increased due to a change in count processes
 - o Conditions are relatively stable from one year to the next
 - Causes for homelessness are stable besides an increase in eviction.

- Review Performance Improvement Measures
 - What are we currently asking, what areas can we improve on, comparison year to year?

 - Give suggestions/guidance on things that are working or not working
 - Ex. Overlap performance indicators with last year's PIT numbers
- Staff to present outcomes by agencies from the last contract period. Subcommittee to review and discuss. We believe it is within our purview to assess the performance of each agency and make recommendations to the CoC. However, staff will seek more guidance from Paul Duncan.
- Review of CoC Performance Measures
 - Dalton plan to compare current Performance Measures with previous years to improve operational measures and policies in house
 - Starting to develop additional metrics to determine racial, age, chronic homelessness, and veteran status breakdowns for successful versus unsuccessful outcomes
 - Jim wants to see not only the numbers, but the quality of data, who we are putting into housing, more of an analysis with the numbers
 - Chris will finalize and send out after meeting is adjourned
