WHEREAS, on November 11, 1986, the City Council adopted Ordinance C-6311, amending the tax increment cap and certain time limitations with respect to the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1994, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-7295, amending certain time limitations with respect to the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 1998, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-7576, extending the time limit for exercise of the power of eminent domain pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan; and
