Aircraft Operations – Aircraft takeoff, landing, or transition through the airspace controlled by the FAA's Long Beach air traffic control tower. Air Carrier – Scheduled carrier, certificated by FAA (FAR) Parts 121/125 or 135, max. takeoff weight over 75,000 lbs.(passengers or cargo). Air Taxi – Aircraft that provide public transportation of persons and/or property on-demand.

General Aviation – Aviation activity other than scheduled air carriers flights, flights by industrial operators, charters and flights by public aircraft. Air Cargo – Cargo carried by aircraft, both inbound and outbound.
