## **OVERSIGHT BOARD MEMBERS**

## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution approving the decision of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach to approve and authorize the City Manager to proceed with demolition of the former Redevelopment Agency property located at 5100-5110 Long Beach Boulevard, and amend the Enforceable Obligation Payment Schedule and Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule as necessary to reflect such demolition costs.

## **DISCUSSION**

Over the past few years, the former Long Beach Redevelopment Agency (Agency) acquired a number of underutilized and non-conforming properties to remove blight and to facilitate new commercial development opportunities.

In September 2009, the Agency acquired the subject property located at 5100-5110 Long Beach Boulevard (Exhibit A). The property is a retail strip center with one remaining tenant scheduled to vacate the premises on December 31, 2012. As tenants have vacated the property, it has been subject to vandalism, squatting, and graffiti. In order to deter further problems, staff, in conjunction with the City's Code Enforcement and Police Department, recommends demolition of the property upon vacation of the premises by the last tenant. The estimated cost is \$52,370. Disposition of the vacated site will be addressed in the Long Range Property Management Plan pursuant to AB 1484.

Oversight Board approval is required to authorize the proposed demolition, and amend the Enforceable Obligation Payment Schedule and Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule as necessary. The maximum cost for additional services under the amendment is \$52,370, which will be funded from the approved property maintenance allowance previously approved in Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule II.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Health & Safety Code Section 34177(a)(1) and subject to Oversight Board approval, the Enforceable Obligation Payment Schedule previously adopted by the Successor Agency will be amended to include the proposed additional payments.
