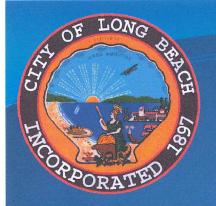
# FY 2014 Proposed One-time Expenditures: Infrastructure

- New North Library (\$1.6 million)
  - Furniture and Equipment (\$1.2 million)
  - Opening Day Collection (\$400,000)
- Replace Computer Reservation System (\$50,000)
- Laptop Tables for 10 Libraries (\$50,000)



## FY 2014 Proposed One Time Expenditures: Critical Facility Upgrades

- Roof Replacements (\$500,000)
- Security Cameras and Security Improvements (\$76,000)
