2014 Municipal Band Update

We understand that a number of Council offices have been contacted regarding the Municipal Band (Band) program. This memo is to provide you with an update on the funding for the 2014 Long Beach Municipal Band (Band) Concert Series.

For the past several years, the goal of the Department of Parks Recreation and Marine (Department) has been to contain costs and to increase non-City support of the Band through private giving, advertising, and sponsorships. Through a combination of City support, private fundraising and sponsorships, the Department was able to provide 20 concerts in 2014 at a cost of approximately \$300,000, or roughly \$15,000 per concert. It should be noted that 2013 fundraising efforts fell about \$9,000 short of the anticipated levels.

2014 Budget

The Department is utilizing a \$300,000 budget to fund Band Concerts for the 2014 Summer Season. This includes \$165,000 in funding approved by the City Council as part of the FY14 Adopted Budget, as well as \$135,000 in private fundraising such as Partners of Parks "pass the bucket" and donations, and a contribution from the Port of Long Beach. A summary of funding sources include:

Refuse	\$50,000
Gas & Oil	\$50,000
POP Fundraising (estimated)	\$85,000
Port of Long Beach Match	\$50,000
Total	\$300,000
