

### Project Site






#### **Hotel Site**

#### **Proposed Project**


- Demolish the existing two-story hotel



## Zone Change CHW to PD-27 Willow Street PD




Zone Change requests the expansion of PD-27 to include three additional parcels

#### **New Six Story Hotel**

- 125 new guestrooms
- 2,498 sf of new conference space
- Fitness room
- New two level parking structure with a total of 385 parking spaces
- New outdoor pool area and new landscaping

- Driveway closure along Willow Street
- New parking deck on top of existing surface parking
- New landscape areas
- New outdoor pool
