



# National, Regional and City Emergency Plans

- The Emergency Operations Plan defines roles and responsibilities for City Departments
- Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) assist
   City Departments in maintaining or resuming operations after an emergency or disaster

# **Training and Exercises**

#### **Annual Coordinated training and exercises include:**

- **Hazmat and Urban Search and Rescue Mobex, 2017** Tested regional capability of the Hazardous materials Team and the Urban Search and Rescue team on response profile for Human initiated attack with a hazardous materials component.
- **Port Protector Cyber Security Exercise** Annual port security exercise in conjunction with the Coast Guard to test the port security network
- LA County Wide Tsunami Communications Exercise, 2017 Tested communications lines with LA County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and conducted Tsunami Walk and Expo
- Dark Tide, 2016 BioWatch exercise that focused on stakeholder notification after a positive detection of a biological agent such as anthrax, and proper methods of environmental sampling, and force protection
- Business Continuity Exercise, 2016 The Ports of L.A. and Long Beach coordinated an exercise to test their ability to return to normal as quickly as possible after a major incident
- Airport Full Scale Emergency Operations Exercise, Triennial To exercise the ability to respond to and recover from a major incident


