Adult Use Cannabis Regulations Study Session



Background

- ☐ In February 2016, the City Council repealed Chapter 5.89 related to Medical Marijuana resulting in the closure of approximately 22 collectives.
- □ November 8, 2016, state voters approved the Control Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act (Proposition 64).
 - -State licensing of adult Use Marijuana businesses to begin in January 2018
- □ November 8, 2016 Ballot Measure MM approved by citizens of Long Beach allowing medical marijuana businesses only.
- ☐ December 19, 2017, City Council adopted a moratorium on Adult-Use Marijuana Businesses.
 - Temporary ban in place through mid-June.
