RES-18-0151 1 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY 4 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH SCI 5 CONSULTING GROUP, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR 6 7 BIDS, TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A FOR VECTOR CONTROL 8 BENEFIT ASSESSMENT 9 SERVICES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000 10 11 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits 12 the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, 13 without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor for 14 actual emergency work when authorized by resolution; and 15 WHEREAS, the City desires to explore the feasibility of pursuing a local 16 revenue measure that would provide funding for mosquito and vector control services in 17 areas of the City not currently covered by a benefit assessment; and 18 WHEREAS, since the approval of Proposition 218, which significantly revised the legal, procedural, and balloting requirements for benefit assessments, SCI 19 20 Consulting Group ("SCI") has successfully established twenty (20) new or increased 21 assessments for mosquito and vector control areas; and 22 WHEREAS, SCI is the only firm in California that has established a post-23 Proposition 218 assessment for vector control services, and has developed a proprietary 24 survey for conducting feasibility studies of new benefit assessments; and 25 WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of 26 27 public funds and staff time; 28 /// 1

Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter
a contract, and any necessary amendments, with SCI Consulting Group, without
advertising for bids, to study the feasibility of establishing a benefit assessment for vector
control services in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000)
for a period of one (1) year, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year
periods, at the discretion of the City Manager.

9 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
10 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
