CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER AUTHORIZATION NO. 4

## PART 1 (Reason for Change)

1. Change Order was required due to a documented change in soil conditions on-site from that referenced in the Geotechnical Report. Resulting in the Contractor having to spend additional effort dredging than planned.

2. Change Order was required for the project did not require the Contractor to provide the 2" thick layer of mulch noted in the plans and specifications. Contractor required to provide a credit for work not performed, as directed by the Project Manager

3. Change Order was required to make various changes including the relocation of the irrigation controller, add rip-rap to reduce erosion, revise the drainage at the dispersion trench, replace the pedestrian bridge handrail, provide additional plants, revise the 6<sup>th</sup> St entrance to incorporate a ramp, replace the projects irrigation heads, replenish the beach, provide some on-site de-weeding, as directed by the Project Engineer.

4. Change Order was required to make various changes including the site de-weeding, replacement of termite damaged wood, label the irrigation lateral lines for reclaimed water, replace damaged gangway planks, and complete the beach improvements, as directed by the Project Engineer.

5. Change Order was required for miscellaneous equipment and material that was not previously included with April and May's various T&M. Equipment included that required for the beach improvements, while materials included the replacement wood for the termite damage and reclaimed water irrigation signage.

6. Change Order was required for the extension of the Contractors project General Conditions due to schedule delays from excessive rain and scope changes, as directed by the Project Engineer.

### **PART 2 (Description of Change)**

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1. Provide all labor, material, and equipment cost for Dixon Marine's change in soil conditions, per RFCO 36 at a lump sum cost.

2. Provide all labor, material, and equipment cost for deletion of the 2" thick layer of mulch, per RFCO 36 at a lump sum cost.

3. Provide all labor, material, and equipment cost for T&M work including the relocation of the irrigation controller, add rip-rap to reduce erosion, revise the drainage at the dispersion trench, replace the pedestrian bridge handrail, provide additional plants, revise the 6<sup>th</sup> St entrance to incorporate a ramp, replace the projects irrigation heads,

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- replenish the beach, provide some on-site de-weeding per RFCO 37 on a time and material basis.
- 4. Provide all labor, material, and equipment cost for T&M work including the site deweeding, replacement of termite damaged wood, label the irrigation lateral lines for reclaimed water, replace damaged gangway planks, and complete the beach improvements, per RFCO 38 for a lump sum cost and 16 working day time extension.
- 5. Provide all material and equipment cost for miscellaneous equipment and material that was not previously included with April and May's various T&M. Equipment included that required for the beach improvements, while materials included the replacement wood for the termite damage and reclaimed water irrigation signage, per RFCO 39 on a time and material basis.
- 6. Provide all labor, material, and equipment cost for extending the project General Conditions for 51 working days, at a lump sum cost.
