


*SPCALA kennel size is approcimately 16" wider than LBACS kennel size.

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LBACS Dogs are Not allowed to use Dog Parks at P.D. Pitchford Animal Companion Village



This is one of three dog parks loctaed at P.D. Pitchford Animal Companion Village which according to Lease Lease-Lase Back is watered at taxpayer expense. SPCALA uses this property to provide servcies for which it collects revenue. LBACS shelter dogs are not allowed to use the dog parks at any time, even though we know dogs thrive when they can play.

SPCALA Marketing Observation "A Model Program of Private and Public Collaboration"

SPCALA uses the City Government seal to create a false narrative that P.D. Pitchford Companion Animal Village is a model program. But the model does is not working well for both parties.

Overheard "There is no municipal shelter director anywhere who would want to use our model."

SPCALA

- operates on prime park land, freeway access, for net \$5 a month, City pays bond debt service
- collects robust adoption, market, grooming, boarding and training revenues
- first pick of municipal cutest shelter dogs, animals with fastest turnover, lowest cost per animal
- maintains "humane" moniker when LBACS kills animals the if inventory of rises
- leverages adoption transactions for soliciting more donations
- leverages City logo to position itself as holding a municipal contract though none exist

LBACS

- operations meet minimum shelter standards
- unable to capture the revenue stream easy to adopt animals and relieve burden on taxpayer by generating fee based revenue.
- dogs are prohibited from playing at village dog parks even though City waters all three lawns
- lacks space to expand, or room to add low cost spay neuter clinic which directly support citywide goal of lowering reproduction rates.
- 58% of LBACS employees are dissatisfied with their jobs
- kills adoptable animals citing it does not have room

Question: Is the City of Long Beach currently authorizing use of City seal even after audit City audit does not support that we are operating as a model for other municipal shelters?
